4. The opening of Act 1 Scene 2 contrasts with Act 1 Scene 1.
 - (a) Describe the opening of Scene 2 (page 9, lines 1 to 20).
 - (b) Describe the setting.
 - (c) What is Miranda begging her father for?
 - (d) Describe Miranda's feelings towards the shipwreck.
 - (e) Explain why Prospero is so confident that 'there's no harm was done' (page 9, line 13)
5. Prospero decides to tell Miranda her life story (page 9, lines 37 to 54). In your own words, explain how much Miranda remembered and what her father told her.

Lesson No. 2 Act 1 Scene 2 (Part 1) (cont'd)

1. Familiarize yourself with the vocabulary lists on pages 15 to 25. While reading make notes.
2. Pretend to be Prospero and read his lines loudly. Next, pretend to be Miranda and then read her lines loudly.
3. Prospero was once the Duke of Milan. Discuss how he lost his power as a leader.
4. Consider the theme **usurpation** (the overthrow of a rightful ruler). Identify and discuss one form of usurpation in Act 1 Scene 1 and Scene 2.
5. Discuss how Prospero and his daughter survive on the island for twelve years.
6. How old is Miranda?
7. Ariel is Prospero's servant. Explain how he carried out Prospero's command to wreck the ship (page 21, lines 195 -214).

1. Ariel demands his freedom and Prospero is annoyed (page 23, lines 242 to 251)
